She saw the end of her world in 2011 when she lost her son, the purpose of her life in a train accident. The grief was endless. No pilgrimage, no travel could heal. "We wanted to do something where we feel our son is always with us. So, we decided to do what he loved doing. That is how we started Nimesh Tanna Charitable Trust". Late Nimesh Tanna loved to help people, put a smile on their face and capture those smiles in his camera. He used to do a lot of things like feeding the hungry and helping the needy. "We can't do everything that he used to do but I can cook and I can feed people". Started from 27 tiffins in 2013, their trust delivers more than 135 tiffins to senior citizens in Mulund. They try to help them in every way possible, not just food. Their drive of help and hope does not stop in Mulund, Tribal areas in Karjat, Nasik, Palghar, etc where cars can't reach, this couple and their friends reach out to help the kids with education and their daily needs. The immense support from their friends and family is what drives the charitable trust ahead every day. What inspires them is the fact that there are a lot of people out there getting inspired by the work they are doing and contributing to their purpose of creating more and more smiles for their son to capture. "My son used to tell me when I become famous people will know you by my name, today when people address me as the founder of Nimesh Tanna charitable trust I feel proud and I know my son kept his words."
